The specially functioning-mechanism makes it possible to produce concrete with extremely low water contents. The desired properties of the fresh concrete can be achieved with moderate dosages.

MC-PowerFlow 7985 has been developed for high early strength precast concrete without compromising on concrete retention ability.

MC-PowerFlow 7985 is added to the concrete during mixing. It is also possible to dose it with the added water. The mixing time should be long enough to allow the admixture to unfold its plasticizing effect completely.
